Arrival time / dress code

Children should arrive at school no earlier than 8.30am and no later than 8.45am on Monday 9th October and the same for the morning of Wednesday 11th October. They should be dressed in clothes and shoes similar to those on the kit list, so that they are ready to take part in their first activity at Water Park. The coach is expected to arrive at Water Park at about 11.30am.

Luggage

Your child should bring their luggage with them when they arrive at school. Parents please drop your child off at the Junior main entrance, but please feel free to stay on the school grounds to wave the coach off.

Medicine

Any medicines including travel sickness tablets for the return journey should be handed to Mrs Waddington (**Monday**) / Miss Wells (**Wednesday**), in a named container, before boarding the coach at the school office. If your child needs to take travel sickness medication, please make sure that they take it before leaving home.

Return Journey

On the return journey, the children will leave Water Park after lunch on **Wednesday 11th October 2023** and **Friday 13th October 2023**. They should arrive back at school for you to collect them at approximately 3.30pm.



It is not possible to know if the coach will arrive back exactly on time, so we would be grateful if you could just arrive at school at the expected time. This will help the parents of Infant children to be clear of the premises. You will be able to wait inside if the coach is slightly late.

Extras

In addition to items on the kit list, your child may take a camera which should be **named** and covered by your home insurance or use a disposable camera.

Children may not take:

Mobile phones, electronic games– they will be too well occupied to need them! We do not want children to take sweets or chewing gum with them, please note no snacks for the coach but a drink of water is recommended. They may bring some 'Souvenir' money, but **no more than £10**. Please make sure that this is in change, and that it is in a named purse/wallet, this will also be collected in with the medicines before the children get on the coach.

Emergency Contact

As the visit is so short, children will not phone home. School will have the phone number; which parents may use to contact Water Park in an emergency.
